

Tammuz organization – Future network Alternatives Program and the Canadian and the European Union In Iraq



Concluded on the social development through a network of the future Iraqi democracy workshop and work with each of the (Canadian Alternatives, an organization of the Canadian network, communication and International Development) and representatives of the European Union of the French Institute, "for a better world, which was held in Iraq / Arbil, for the period 1 - 6 March 2009.

The workshop was attended by a number of officials on the program, including Mr. Director-General of the "alternatives" Canadian Michel Lambert, who said at the opening of the workshop that his organization operates under the slogan "together to build a better world" and seeks to support the movement of social reform aimed at building social justice in the world, presenting programs of his organization in Iraq since 2003, which resulted in the establishment of the democratic future of Iraq, which includes membership in the four years of Iraq. Were to enable the network and support during the period 2005 to 2008.

As a result of the success achieved by the network in its work in Iraq over the past years has been re-implementation of the program for another two years 2009-2011.

Also saw the opening session of the workshop on day one, the participation of Mr George Mansour, Minister of the province of civil society in the Kurdistan regional government, which in turn, through its support for the work of organizations and networks operating in Iraq and seeking to provide all necessary facilities to activate the role of community organizations in Kurdistan and Iraq, calling on the Canadian and international organizations to support the movement in Iraq, and emphasis on democratization in post-dictatorship, and to support civil organizations working for the first building blocks for the new Iraq

the areas of media development and capacity-building mechanism and the building of networks of civil organizations to support democracy and the establishment of the concepts of human rights and social justice in Iraq.

Objective of this workshop was the signing of a contract of employment and the development of new program plans and the establishment of appropriate strategies for the implementation of the program network, which includes rehabilitation and development capabilities of member organizations in the network and support the implementation of small projects in line with the objectives of the network, and support three rehabilitation centers for young people of both sexes in Iraq, as well as to foster and encourage the establishment of a number of national and international campaigns that contribute to injustice or to finding solutions to the problems facing Iraqi society, as the program is to expand the membership of the network over the next two years.

Represent Tammuz Organization for Social Development on the core to form a network where the network has adopted the draft and the relationship with the alternatives of Canada since 2003 and the subsequent relations with other international organizations. Now regarded as Tammuz organization one of the most important members of the organization are coordinated for the project and at the same time represents one of the coordinating body for the network.

It should be noted that the network of the future of democracy is a network consisting of 14 Iraqi organization representing diverse segments of the terms of reference and the sons of the Iraqi people as well as the scope of work, which includes all over Iraq. It is large-scale projects carried out by the future of democracy in cooperation with the recent Tammuz, the draft control the process of updating the voter register during the period from 7-25 through 28/8/2008, to monitor the elections of members of provincial councils, which took place in January 31 last, which was a number of the future of democracy 20 thousand observers of both sexes in cooperation with the Friedrich Ebert Foundation of Germany and the United Nations.
