
TAMMUZ ORGANIZATION REPORT FOR MONITORING THE PROCESS OF COUNTING AND SORTING FOR THE DAYS (WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, AND FRIDAY) 5-6-7 OF MAY 2010

Tammuz organization for social development is proceeding in monitoring the process of counting and sorting for the boxes of Baghdad province. The process is continuing normally under the supervision of our observers and the political parties representatives and the under the sights of the international observers.

The IHEC made press conference ion Thursday May 1 in 12:45 p.m. attended by the council of commissioners in the IHEC (Faraj Alhayderi, Hamdiya Alhuseini, Saad Alrawe, Ayad Alkinani, Kareem Altimimi, and the Egyptian ambassador and the representative of the Arabic League). Mr. Kareem Altimimi commented in the conference that the numbers of sorted boxes up to 12:00 p.m. of May 6 2010 were 2644 boxes and the process will be finalized after 12 to 15 days.

Tammuz organization is monitoring the process of transferring and the boarding of the boxes from the storehouses of Rosafa and Kharkh district to Alrasheed Hotel. Our observers have searched the boxes in case they contain any violations of breaking.

Tammuz organization has also sent its observers to monitor the electronic entering of the data in telecenter. The preparations for the electronic entering of the data took place in Wednesday May 5 and on Thursday May 6 the process of entering was opened and continued normally by entering 1650 balloting station.

On the other hand, our observers presented these observations:

- 1- Losing one of the balloting boxes in Ma'moon station.
- 2- The discrepancy between the number of cards and the signatures in the in the voting Register as for example the number of the cards was 259 whereas the signatures were 264.

- 3- in one of the stations, the boxes numbers were incompatible with numbers on the boxes locks and this case happened in many balloting stations.
- 4- In one of the stations, the locks numbers were not compatible after the checking of them and our observers noticed two voting sheets were being put for another list and the process continued.
- 5- In hall number 2, an opened box was brought and our observers informed about this case.
- 6- In other stations, the number of voting sheets in sheet number 501 was 250 but in the signatures book, there were 375 signatures. After the checking of the voting sheets, it was shown that the numbers of sheets are 375.
- 7- The ex-parliamentarian and the candidate of the Iraqi List; Aliya Naseef attended the counting and sorting headquarter.
- 8- The candidate of the coalition of the Iraq Unity; Ayad Alta'ee attended to headquarter of counting and sorting.
- 9- It was noted that some political entities representatives were hasty in submitting their complaints and after checking, it was found that their complaints were not sound.
- 10- Some 42 voting sheets were abolished because disappearance of the seals from them.
- 11- Our observers notified the conveyors of the boxes from the storehouses that one of the boxes has red lace and required to be checked before transferring it.
