1. The legislative side: and include the constitution, and articles that serve the work of organizations, as well as materials which impede the work of organizations and discuss the role of organizations and the gaps in the work of organizations and ways of finding solutions to those gaps through projects and programs .
2. The community side: and include the social and economic (poverty, disease, ignorance, unemployment) clan, the weakness of citizenship, cultural and educational side and accept each other .
3. The political side: and include the (security, government intervention, financial and administrative corruption, political parties and quotas) by building the capacity of civil society organizations: includes the institutions, personnel development, and other sources of funding, cooperation and networking, advocacy, media and pressure groups) .
4. Legal side: the rule of law, the legal framework of the organizations, human rights, minority rights and the independence of the organizations.
